Now comes the District Attorney of Dallas County, Texas and asks the Court to dismiss the above entitled and numbered cause, for the following reasons, to-wit:


This case was filed by the Southern Methodist Police Department as a THEFT \$2500, SJF case on March 9, 2016. The Defendant was arrested and arraigned on March 11, 2016 and the case was indicted on December 20, 2017.

On March 23, 2018 the Defendant's Motion for Speedy Trial was GRANTED, after testimony about the Defendant's experience with the bonding company, the concern and anxiety associated with the consequences of the legal system, and the loss of job opportunities. It has been determined that the State is unable to proceed with the case against the Defendant in this matter.

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, the State respectfully requests that this case be dismissed.


ORDER OF DISMISSAL
