**STATE’S OFFER**

If Defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere to the following crime(s), the State will recommend the following sentences:

COUNT 1: Possession of a controlled dangerous substance, METHAMPHETAMINE, with intent to distribute, within 2,000 feet of a school, 63 O.S. Section 2-401 (F), a FELONY, committed on January 31, 2017 (after three prior felony convictions)

COUNT 2: Possession of a controlled dangerous substance, MARIJUANA, with intent to distribute, within 2,000 feet of a school, 63 O.S. Section 2-401 (F), a FELONY, committed on January 31, 2017 (after three prior felony convictions)

COUNT 3: Attempting to elude officers while endangering others, 21 O.S. Section 540A (B), a FELONY, committed on January 31, 2017 (after three prior felony convictions)

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Defendant \_\_\_\_\_ is GUILTY of the above-described crime(s) and is sentenced as follows:

**TERM OF IMPRISONMENT**

COUNT 1: TWENTY (20) YEARS in the custody and control of the Department of Corrections;

COUNT 2: TWENTY (20) YEARS in the custody and control of the Department of Corrections;

COUNT 3: TWENTY (20) YEARS in the custody and control of the Department of Corrections.

Counts 1, 2 and 3 shall run CONCURRENTLY with each other.
