

Judge hurt in scooter accident

Sixth District Judge Eric Clifford was scheduled for surgery at Plano Medical Center this morning after being taken by helicopter with non-life threatening injuries after a one-vehicle accident in Blossom Sunday afternoon, according to his daughter Sarah Clifford.

The judge has knee and shoulder injuries after allegedly wrecking a street legal motor scooter, Lamar County Court-at-Law Judge Bill Harris said.

Clifford called 911 a little before 2:30 p.m., according to police records, and was taken by helicopter to a Plano hospital.
